

Government guidance to schools (November 2020)

The [World Health Organisation published a statement on 2st August about children and face coverings](#). They now advise that “children aged 12 and over should wear a mask under the same conditions as adults, in particular when they cannot guarantee at least a 1-metre distance from others and there is widespread transmission in the area.”

Government guidance to schools (November 2020)

Where anybody is struggling to access a face covering, or where they are unable to use their face covering due to having forgotten it or it having become soiled or unsafe, education settings should take steps to have a small contingency supply available to meet such needs.

Granville Academy's Policy and Expectations

- Masks are to be worn during student line ups (this allows staff to check all students have their mask and to set-up a positive entrance into the buildings).
- Masks are to be worn on entrance and exit to indoor spaces
- Masks are to be worn in all indoor spaces and should be removed once seated in the classroom.
- Students exempt from wearing a mask (medical evidence will be provided by parent/carer) will be issued with a purple lanyard.

All students must bring a mask to school and we would prefer students to have a **spare in their bags**.

We appreciate that this item on the **odd occasion** may be **forgotten, lost or soiled**. Our consequence system accounts for this.

However, **Granville Academy** are **repeatedly issuing masks** and our stocks are being depleted on a daily basis. This utilises funding that could be used elsewhere to support teaching and learning and therefore progress.

What happens if I repeatedly forget my mask?

1 instance in a week

Mask is provided by the student receptionist

2 instances in a week

Mask is provided by the student receptionist and an Restorative 30 detention issued for the same day. A call will be made by the Head of Year to establish the issues at home and a plan moving forward involving the student, parent/carer and Academy.

3 instances in a week


Mask is provided by the student receptionist and a Restorative 60 detention issued for the same day. A call will be made by the Head of Year to establish the issues at home and a plan moving forward involving the student, parent/carer and Academy.

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We all need to play our part:


Students – pack your bag the night before, ensuring you have a mask to wear and a spare.
